IDEA COMPETITION – Higher education

An important element of Danish Entrepreneurship Award is the Idea Competition. It runs parallel for the three levels of the Danish educational system; higher education being one of them.

On these pages you can read about the Idea Competition and the rules and sign-up procedures.

How does the Idea Competition work?

In short – as a participant in the Idea Competition you have to:

- Type in a written presentation (max. 4800 characters) **deadline Tuesday October 29, 2019, at** 12.00
- Pitch your idea for a judge twice each time 4 minutes pitch, 4 minutes feedback
- Visit the Counseling Zone (Rådgivningszonen) and get advice

Written presentation

To be part of the Idea Competition you must type in a written presentation of your idea in advance of Danish Entrepreneurship Award. The written presentation has a limit of max. 4800 characters, spaces included, and it has to be typed into an online form via "Min side". It is NOT possible to upload a file like a pdf or otherwise. In the presentation you have to use the template and describe present your idea, according to the criteria found here.

We only accept written presentations typed into the online form, so you cannot submit it by email or any other way. The written presentation has to be typed in no later than **Tuesday October 29, 2019, at 12.00**.

Pitch

At Danish Entrepreneurship Award must pitch their idea for a judge twice. The pitch lasts 4 minutes. After the pitch the team receives four minutes of feedback from the judge.

When all teams have been through the 1st pitch round, the 2nd pitch round starts – same procedure as in 1st round.

You can use "props" for the pitch, e.g. computer, Power Point, video, sketches, prototypes and so on, but you have to bring all of the equipment yourself. There is no access to power, projector or otherwise at the pitch rounds.



When all teams have finished their pitches, the winning team from each of the four categories will be announced and qualified for the final. The four category winners will be announced at 13.30 and the final starts at 14.00.

The final

In the final, the four category winners compeed to become the overall winner of the Idea Competition for further educations. Each team will have four minutes to pitch for a panel of three-four judges. The final pitch is on a stage and after the four minutes, the judges can ask additional questions

In the final, you can also use "props" like computer, Power Point, video, sketches, prototypes and so on, but this time you will have access to power and a projector. It is a good idea to prepare a visual presentation (e.g. slides, PowerPoint or Prezi) to use in case you qualify for the final.

After the four final pitches, the judges will deliberate and the overall winner for the further educations will be announced during the Award show.

Feedback from the judges and visit to the Counselling zone

We recommend appointing someone in the team to write down all the great advice, tips and tricks from the feedback you get during the day, both from the judges and in the Counselling zone. This way you will not have forgotten it when you get home and continue the development of your idea.

Prizes

The overall winner receives a prize of DKK 10.000

Judging in the Idea Competition

Judges

The judges are representatives from businesses and organisations in Denmark. They judge both the written presentation, the pitches and the final.

Judging of the pitches and the finale

The four category winners are found by adding the scores from the written presentation (judged prior to the Award) and the two pitches. The team with the highest score in each category qualifies for the final. The category winners will be announced at 13.30 and the final starts at 14.00.

The winner is the team with the highest score in the final. This means that the score from the written presentation and the pitches does NOT count in the final.

Judging criteria

There are a set of judging criteria for both the written presentation and the pitches. The final is evaluated by the same criteria as the pitches. See all the judging criteria here.

Information about score and ranking

After Danish entrepreneurship Award all participating teams will receive an email with information about their score and ranking in the competition.

Rules for participation

You can participate as a one-man team but we recommend at least two or three team members. All members on the team must sign up and you can only enter one idea per team.

At sign-up you choose one member to be the contact for the team. He or she will receive emails with information about the competition.

You cannot participate if:

- You have registered a CVR-number prior to the competition.
- You have made money on your idea (sponsorships from companies or other partners are allowed)

• Your idea already exists - copying is not allowed. Ideas are often based on existing inventions, but it has to be a further development of the existing and it has to create a new value.

Before and during the competition we will be doing random checks to ensure participants are following the rules.

Categories

At sign-up you enter you idea in one of four categories:

GreenTech

Better use of resources, recycling and green solutions

Social Entrepreneurship

Creation of social value for individual or society, nationally or globally

LifeTech

Developments within welfare, health care or learning

Serviceinnovation

Development of experience and user design


Sign-up Guide for the Idea Competition

This guide has four steps – some for the teacher, some for the students:


- Step 1: The teacher registers
- Step 2: The teachers creates his or her teams
- Step 3: The team signs up for the competition (can only be done by the team contact person)
- Step 4: The team types in the written presentation no later than **Tuesday October 29, 2019 at 12.00**

Step 1: Teacher registration


Go to the website of Danish Entrepreneurship Award and click "Sign-up for the Idea Competition"




Choose "Idékonkurrencen for videregående uddannelser" in the drop-down menu.



Type in your information.




You will reeceive a confirmation email (if not, check your spam filter) – click on "bekræft din tilmelding her". You will now be forwarded to "Min side" where you type in additional information – Name, Phone number, Education – and click "Bekræft".




Step 2: Create team(s)

You are now at "Min side" where you as a teacher can create the teams which are going to sign up for the Idea Competition. If you are in Start Up Programme this site is where you end up when you log on via "Min side login" at www.ffe-ye.dk. Click "Opret Team" to create a team.




Type in the team name and click "Opret".




Type in emails and names for each of the team members and click "Tilføj".

NOTICE – you must choose one member to be the team contact person. This is done by checking the box in the column "Leder".



All members of the team will now receive a confirmation email (if not, check your spam filter), click on "bekræft din tilmelding her". You will now be forwarded to "Min side" where you type in additional information – Name, Phone number, Password (Repeat password), Education – and click "Bekræft".

The team can now sign up for the Idea Competition (can only be done by the team contact person or the teacher).




Step 3: Sign-up for the competition


This step has an A and a B track, depending on whether you are a teacher or a student.

Step 3.A – Sign-up for the competition: Teacher


As a teacher you can see and sign-up your teams at "Min side". Sign up the teams by clicking "Tilmeld team" under "Events" and "Danish Entrepreneurship Award".




Sign-up the teams by clicking "Gå til tilmelding" by each team.



Check "Idékonkurrencen", then the category and finally "Tilmeld".




Repeat these steps for each team – when all teams are signed up, the list will look like this:




Step 3.B - Sign-up for the competition: Students

All registered members of the team have been sent a confirmation email (if not, check your spam filter), click on "bekræft din tilmelding her". You will now be forwarded to "Min side" where you type in additional information – Name, Phone number, Password (Repeat password), Education – and click "Bekræft".

As the team contact person you sign up your team through "Min side". Sign up for the Idea Competition by clicking "Tilmeld team" under "Events" and "Danish Entrepreneurship Award".




Check "Idékonkurrencen", then the category and finally "Tilmeld".




Step 4: Type in the written presentation

As team contact person you have to type in the team's written presentation by logging in to "Min side". You will get to this page and click "Bidrag".



Type in your presentation in the white box.


When you are done, click "Færdig".



You now have two options:

"Gem dit bidrag" – clicking this means that you can return and make changes later on. The presentation has NOT been turned in yet.

"Aflever dit bidrag" – clicking this means you are done with the presentation and want to turn it in. This means you can NOT make changes anymore.



Once you have clicked "Aflever dit bidrag", you will get a message confirming that your presentation has been turned in. Now click "Luk".
